### Historic Dayton cemetery vandalized

### DAYTON, Ohio (AP) -- In Dayton, vandals have struck a recently rediscovered cemetery from the 1800s.

Volunteers who've been cleaning up the graveyard say since their last visit in the fall, nearly all the headstones have been broken and scattered, and several may be missing.

Lisa O'Hearn, who's been leading the restoration effort, says you'd need a sledge hammer to knock down some of the stones.

Police say they found no evidence to lead them to whoever caused the damage. They're now patrolling the cemetery, the final resting place for several Montgomery County pioneers.
